Assessments:

Spectrum Global Arts students are assessed on a formal and informal basis, and assessments will involve a mix of practical and theoretical work. The majority of assessments are practical.

Graduates of the CUA40120 Certificate IV in Dance may be employed in a variety of dance performance contexts. Successful completion of the CUA40120 Certificate IV in Dance can lead to further training in the CUA50220 Diploma of Musical Theatre or CUA51520 Diploma of Dance (Elite Performance).
